

## Plan for opening Church for Worship

Please ensure that the following guidance is followed:

### **HELP KEEP THIS VENUE COVID-19 SECURE**


1. **You must not enter if you or anyone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms.**
2. **If you develop COVID-19 symptoms within 7 days** of visiting these premises alert Test, Track and Trace. Alert Lindsay Scott and alert the organiser of the activity you attended.
3. **Maintain 2 metres social distancing as far as possible:** Wait behind the marked lines as you go through the entrance to your activity and observe the one-way system marked.
4. **Use the hand sanitiser provided** on entering the premises. Clean your hands often. Soap and paper towels are provided.
5. **Avoid touching your face, nose, or eyes.** Clean your hands if you do.
6. **“Catch it, Bin it, Kill it”.** Tissues should be disposed of into one of the rubbish bags provided. Then wash your hands.
7. **The organisers regularly clean door handles, tables, other equipment, sinks and surfaces before you arrive.** Keep them clean. We clean all surfaces in the building on a regular basis and provide soap and water and hand sanitizer.
8. **Take turns to use confined spaces such as corridors, and toilet areas.** Standing or sitting next to someone is lower risk than opposite them. Briefly passing another person in a confined space is low risk.
9. **Keep the hall well ventilated. Close doors and windows on leaving.**
10. **Whilst parking maintain social distancing from the next car.**
11. **Whilst entering and exiting the venue maintain social distancing.**
12. **Seating within the venue will be managed to ensure social distancing is maintained and congregants maintain social groupings.**

Please note that every effort has been made to follow current Government Guidelines

A one-way system has been implemented see plan below:

It is requested that everyone adheres to the guidelines and the signage that has also been implemented.

To maintain the safety of the congregation during this time, it requested that no-one enters the rest of the building ( to include reception area, the sports hall, the kitchen and all of the offices and preschool rooms on the upper floor.)

The Deacons/Stewards will advise and assist as required.
